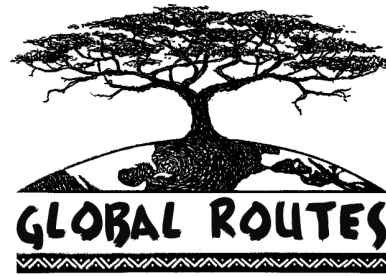


NEW ORLEANS AND THE GULF COAST
